Wilshamstead Parish Council

Planning Application For Up To 149 Houses At Duck End Lane Recommended For Refusal

Reported previously was that the Borough Council Planning Committee made up of elected Borough Ward Councillors members, had considered this planning application at the November meeting, making a recommendation for this application to be refused. The members had heard strong objections being raised by a number of representatives from the Wilstead community.

The Parish Council response had been robust with an experienced planning consultant being commissioned to provide a detailed technical challenge to the local authority to this planning application at Duck End Lane.

In the previous update, the next steps were the application was due to return to a future Planning Committee, with this allowing the Planning Officer to have prepared a range of supporting planning policy reasons for a refusal. The committee members would then vote on the application outcome.

The Parish Council are aware that this application has not returned to the Planning Committee to date. The Parish Council are also mindful that this delay, could potentially bring future challenge from the applicant. Therefore, the Parish Council are monitoring this matter very closely.

Major Gas Main Replacement Works Latest

Regrettably, it remains at the time of writing, the Parish Council has still heard nothing further regarding these works which had previously been due to start on 10th November. This is disappointing and please be assured that if any further information whatsoever is received regarding the start date of the gas main replacement works taking place on Bedford Road towards the roundabout and down along Cotton End Road as far as Ivy Lane, this will be communicated across various local platforms by the Parish Council.

Highways Safety In Littleworth

Following the installation of the average speed cameras on Cotton End Road, the Parish Council had wished to look at redeployment of two of the vehicle activated signs along Cotton End Road to increase the coverage in other parts of the parish, as improving highways safety is important to the Parish Council.

Parish Council representatives recently attended a site meeting with a local authority Highways Officer to look at Littleworth. The locations of some highway's poles have been agreed, these will be installed shortly, to enable this part of the village to have signage in situ in due course.

Footway Maintenance In Bedford Road

Bedford Borough Council have advised that there will be footway maintenance works at Bedford Road, Service Road Wilstead as part of this year's annual programme. The intended scope of the scheme is to resurface the footway from, the farm entrance approximately 50m from the Eastern service road entrance to outside House no. 57.

The works have now been programmed by the local authority contractor DJT Surfacing and are planned to take place between 05th January and 26th January with detailed information being sent in a letter to the local residents that the works will have a bearing upon.

Village Improvements Update

There will be two new bins installed to upgrade existing bins, the red dog bin located at the junction between Whitworth Way and Wooding Way has rotted away and will be replaced with a Plaza Style bin that will be able to take dog and general waste. There will also be a new bin to replace the one sadly destroyed by fire, at the entrance to the village car park on Whitworth Way.

The order has been placed with the local authority for these installations, though Bedford Borough Council have advised they do currently have a backlog with installations so there is no known timescale at present for the installation.

Jubilee Way Playing Field

The Parish Council are looking at options to enhance the facilities at the Jubilee Way Playing Field. Some of these are ambitious plans to improve the kitchen and storage space (by extending) the building itself. Others include the replacement of the dilapidated knee rail fence and the installation of new equipment adjacent to the MUGA. One the current suggestions is to move the knee rail further into the grassed area and construct a new barrier thus allowing more parking space. We are also considering the idea of placing some outdoor Gym equipment into this area adjacent to the MUGA, we have also looked at the idea of outdoor table tennis tables. This equipment would be essentially free to use for all residents.

The parish Council would welcome feedback on these proposals or any suggestions relating to the equipment we may be able to supply. Please send feedback/suggestions to: office@wilsteadparishcouncil.org.

The intention is to keep the two football pitches and support the Wilstead teams but ideally we would like to see greater recreational use of the area by more parish residents.

Just a quick reminder that the Jubilee Centre and MUGA are available for hire. The MUGA has (PAYG) floodlights so evening sessions over the darker nights are easily accommodated. Please contact the Jubilee Centre directly for details.

Village Agents provide a free, confidential service and are here to help people over 60 with a variety of issues – large or small. We are funded by Bedford Borough Council. We are all DBS checked and operate in the strictest confidence. Andrea is the Village Agent for Wilstead.

Support with Blue Badges - if you have a permanent disability or illness that limits your walking ability then you may be entitled to apply for a Blue Badge. This enables you to park in disabled bays closer to your destination. You don't have to be a driver to apply, you can use the badge in any vehicle as long as you are a passenger. Andrea can help you apply.

Attendance Allowance - is a non-means tested benefit for people over state retirement age to help with extra costs incurred because of a severe illness or disability. You could get as much as £110.40 per week. Andrea can help you to claim if you think you might qualify.

Disabled toilet access key - Some disabled toilets can only be used by people who have a special RADAR key. If you have a disability that means you need to use a disabled toilet, call Andrea for a free RADAR key

Help with form filling - many older people aren't claiming the benefits they are entitled to. Andrea can help identify which benefits you can claim by doing a confidential benefits check. We can also help you fill in those complicated forms such as Attendance Allowance forms, Carer's Allowance, Council Tax Support and Blue Badges.

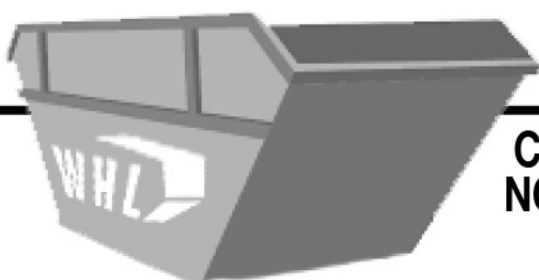

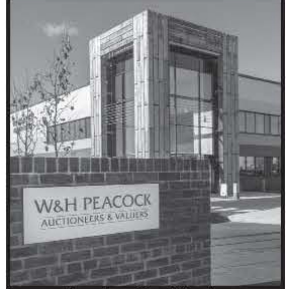
