Planning Application For Up To 149 Houses At Duck End Lane Recommended For Refusal Latest - Taken To Planning Appeal

The Borough Council Planning Committee made up of elected Borough Ward Councillors members, had made a recommendation for this application to be refused. Strong objections were raised by a number of representatives from the Wilstead community.

The Parish Council response had been robust with an experienced planning consultant being commissioned to provide a detailed technical challenge to the local authority to this planning application at Duck End Lane.

The next steps were the application was due to return to a future Planning Committee, to allow the Planning Officer to prepare a range of planning policy reasons for a refusal. The committee members would then vote on the application outcome.

The Borough Council Planning Case Officer for this application has unfortunately confirmed that the applicant decided to lodge an appeal to the Planning Inspectorate of Non-determination on 3rd December rather than wait for the Planning Committee to refuse the application on the 8th December. The application is now with the Planning Inspectorate to consider. The applicants had requested a 2 day public enquiry, but whether this will be the approach and when the appeal will be held will be for the Inspectorate to decide and advise.

The Parish Council and any members of the public who commented on the original application, will be contacted and advised how the appeal will be dealt with, and if it is to be a Hearing or Public Enquiry you will be informed of when this will be held. At the time of writing this information has not been confirmed by the Inspectorate, when it has been, the Parish Council will update the community across the usual different platforms.

Recently, there has been the reserved application for the 95 houses at Cotton End Road, which details the site layout being put forward. The information for the application is 25/02560/MAR. Reserved matters relating to matters of layout, scale, appearance and landscaping for the erection of 95 dwellings, public open space and play facilities, SUDs features and associated infrastructure pursuant to Outline Planning Permission 24/02231/MAO Land At Village Farm 85 Cotton End Road Wilstead Bedford Bedfordshire MK45 3DB.

Planning Development In Wilstead

The Parish Council are very aware of the worry over these recent speculative planning applications being received in Wilstead. As usual, the Parish Councillors as well as the Borough Ward Councillors are monitoring the evolving situation closely. To ensure the Parish Council remain pro-active and not reactive, there is already work taking place to look at ensuring robust representations are collated, in relation to both these sites, with this being planned in to ensure the Parish Council can act promptly to safeguard the village from this level of new development.

Jubilee Way Playing Field Enhancements Update

The Parish Council would like to thank everyone who so very kindly took the time to feedback on the options being looked at to further enhance the facilities at the Jubilee Way Playing Field. Whilst some of these are ambitious, such as plans to improve the kitchen and storage space (by extending) the building itself, alongside plans to replace the dilapidated knee rail fence and the installation of new equipment adjacent to the MUGA. It was great to receive such overwhelming support being fed back to all the suggestions, as well as much higher volumes of responses received than expected to the ideas that included placing some outdoor Gym equipment in the area adjacent to the MUGA, with some outdoor table tennis tables. With the intention this equipment would be essentially free to use for all residents.

The Parish Council are now taking these ideas and progressing the next steps, with updates being shared across various platforms as the plans progress.





Borough Councillors Report

I am pleased to report that progress is at long last being made on delivering a local GP surgery, located at Wixams, to serve Wilstead residents. Like much Wixams infrastructure, the long-anticipated GP surgery has frequently been a case of 'two steps forward and one step back'. I attended my first meeting to discuss a potential new GP surgery as long ago as 2011. Until quite recently we were frequently told 'there is no money' and both the NHS and Bedford Council seemed completely disengaged from the idea.

After much pressure from residents, Wixams and Wilstead PC, Wixams Community Group and your Borough Councillors, things have started to move in the right direction.

A regular series of meetings and updates (with actions!) has been put in place, between Bedford Council, the ICB, Urban & Civic (the developers) and your local Borough Councillors.

From the latest discussion, I can advise the following:

- The proposed surgery will be on a currently vacant plot in Wixams Town Centre
- Urban & Civic have produced two concept designs for the surgery
- The ICB has reviewed the designs and recommend some amendments, which Urban & Civic have now incorporated
- Further discussions between Urban & Civic and the ICB will take place in late January
- Indicative costs of the surgery and a timeline for delivery and construction are due by 26th February
- A public consultation meeting will take place shortly (date to be agreed) before a planning application is then formally submitted to Bedford Council.

It will be a big step forward when we get to see the surgery project timelines in a few weeks. Obviously, there is a lot still to be done, including getting planning approval, construction of the building, and securing a GP practice that wants to take on a new surgery, but it is looking more positive than ever before that we will get our long-promised GP surgery.

For those of us making the 14-mile round trip to Ampthill whenever we need to see our GP, it can't come soon enough.



Meeting with Blake Stephenson

Thank you to everybody who came to my Wilstead meeting in January with local councillors Graeme Coombes and Marc Frost. I'm extremely grateful to The Woolpack for hosting us – it's been tough for the hospitality sector so I'm determined to make sure we keep backing our fantastic local pubs.

Some of the issues we discussed included potholes, flooding concerns and a new bench between Wixams Retirement Village and Seasons Garden Centre.

Also discussed was Universal Studios in Stewartby which I believe it will bring huge economic benefits to our local communities – jobs, major investment and increase in footfall for other local businesses. I completely understand that communities, like Wilstead, have many concerns about the potential impact and disruption to village life, particularly how the already congested A421 and surrounding roads, will cope with increased pressure. I have a strong relationship with the team at Universal and have been feeding back issues raised with me. I will continue to push for robust, forward looking transport and infrastructure planning so that local communities are protected and the benefits of the development are enjoyed without adding undue strain to daily life.

The future of the Wixams GP surgery was another key topic raised. Borough Councillor Graham Combes covers this in detail in his report.

I also answered questions on the effectiveness of the Civil Service and MPs expenses, and provided an overview of my responsibilities as Parliamentary Private Secretary to the Shadow Treasury team. Also my work on the Public Accounts Committee and the Environmental Audit Committee, which help me scrutinise government decisions and represent local priorities in Parliament.
